3. Agreement to School Terms and Local Legislation

By registering for and attending a Chue Style Feng Shui® course run through (School Name), the student agrees to comply with the school's General Terms and Conditions and with the legislation of the country in which the course is held.

4. Application and Registration

Applications must be submitted via the official Chue Foundation website course listing. The host school will then provide full course details and instructions for payment of the deposit to secure a place.

Enrolment in Chue Style feng shui courses is open only to individuals who have reached the legal age of adulthood in their country of residence.

5. Application Deadlines

All Chue Style Feng Shui® courses have a clearly stated application closing date, typically four weeks prior to the course start date. Applications received after this deadline will not be accepted.

6. Payments, Deposits and Cancellations

Courses are required to be paid in full before commencement, unless the school offers a particular financial agreement to the student.

A non-refundable deposit of approximately 20% of the course fee is required to secure a place. If the course is cancelled by the school, the deposit will be refunded minus any bank or exchange charges. If the student cancels, the deposit is forfeited. If written cancellation is not received at least seven days before the course start date, the student is liable for the full course fee.

If the student cancels attending the course mid-session or does not attend any particular session, they are still liable to pay the course if full.

7. Course Confirmation and Status

Courses proceed once a minimum number of registered students has been reached. Students who book travel or accommodation before confirmation of the course going ahead do so at their own risk.

8. Right of Entry

Admission to Chue Style Feng Shui® courses is at the discretion of the host school, the teacher, and ultimately the President of the Chue Foundation.

9. Personal Responsibility and Insurance
